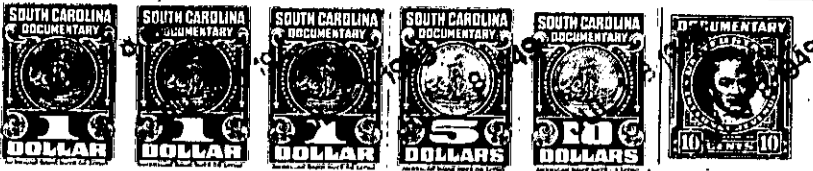

Know All Men by These Presents:

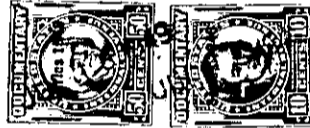
That We, George W. Barnett and Kathryn M. Barnett in the State aforesaid,  
in consideration of the sum of Nine Thousand and no/100 DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said B. B. Smith

All that certain, piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the northwest side of West Prentiss Avenue, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 14 of Block G on plat of O. P. Mills property, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County South Carolina in Plat Book F, at page 171, and having, according to said plat, and a recent survey made by A. Newton Stall, January 15, 1940, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northwest side of West Prentiss Avenue, Joint corner of Lots Nos. 12 and 14 of Block G, said pin also being 372 feet in a westerly direction from the northwest corner of the intersection of West Prentiss Avenue and Mission Street, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 12 N. 44-33 W. 180 feet to an iron pin on the southeast side of a 16 foot alley; thence with said alley S. 45-27 W. 62 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 16 S. 44-33 E. 180 feet to an iron pin on the northwest side of West Prentiss Avenue; thence with the northwest side of said avenue N. 45-27 E. 62 feet to the beginning corner.

Being the same property conveyed to George W. Barnett and Kathryn M. Barnett by deed of G. R. Kay dated February 8, 1945 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 272, page 118.
