BEGINNING at a point in the center of a County Road and running thence S. 15-15 W., 753 ft. to an iron pin in line of Lollis property; thence with Lollis line S. 73-40 W., 360 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 1-42 E., 627.6 feet to a point near said County Road; thence to and along said County Road N. 63-22 E., 438 feet to stake in said Road; thence still with said Road N. 88-00 E., 132 feet to the point of beginning.
