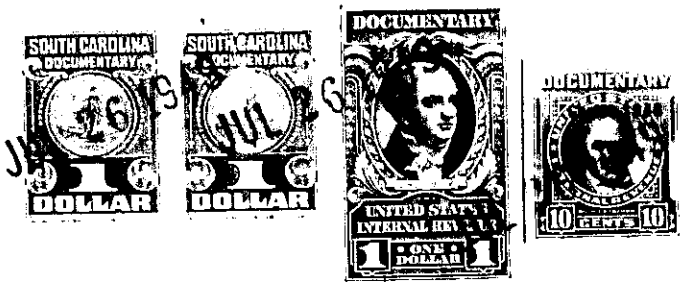

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Mrs. Willis E. Gary

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred Dollars
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by Paul Edwin Abercrombie

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Paul Edwin Abercrombie his Heirs and Assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Fairview Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina and containing 7.53 acres, more or less, according to a plat and survey made by E. E. Gary, Surveyor, October 26, 1946, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin in the eastern edge of the Babbtown Road, corner of other lands of Mary C. Stoddard, running thence with line of Stoddard N. 40 E. 13.62 to an iron pin; thence S. 5 1/2 W. 14.61 to an iron pin; thence S. 54 W. 5.54 to an iron pin in the eastern edge of the Babbtown road; thence with said road N. 19 1/2 W. 7.78 to an iron pin, the point of beginning, and bounded by said Babbtown road, lands of Mary C. Stoddard, J. P. Kellett, Sloan and others.
