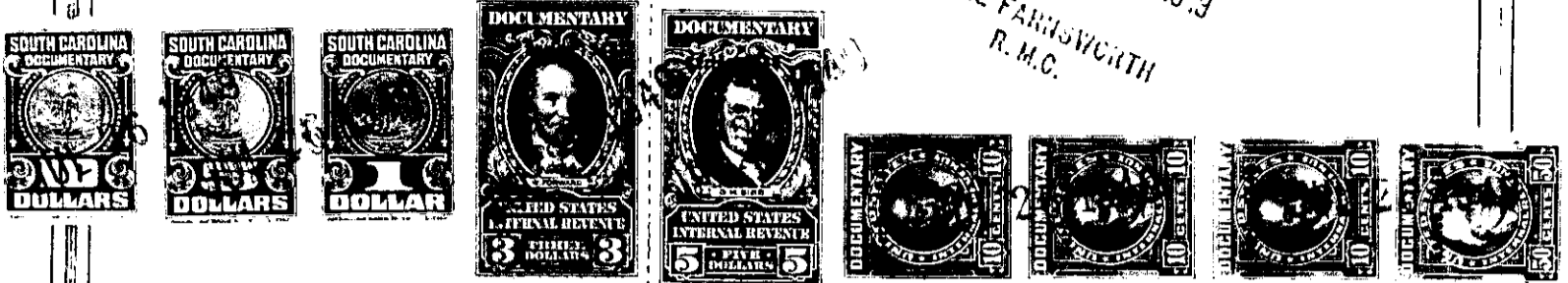

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents  
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said **King H. Miller, his heirs and assigns:**.....

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in **Greenville** Township, **Greenville**  
County, State of South Carolina, in School District 3-9 and known as Lot 3 of **Lawrence Wood Hills**, according to a plat of property made by **Delton S. Lewis**, the said author, 1940 as revised June 1, 1941 as revised October, 1941, recorded in Plat Book "111", at page 33.

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of **Low Hill** at east of joint corner of lots 7 and 8; thence N. 48-05 E. 180 feet to an iron pin, joint near corner of Lots 7 and 8; thence N. 71-55 W. 60 feet to an iron pin, joint near corner of Lots 8 and 11; thence S. 48-05 E. 180 feet to an iron pin on **Low Hill Street**, joint corner of Lots 8 and 9; thence S. 71-55 W. 60 feet to an iron pin on **Low Hill Street** to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
