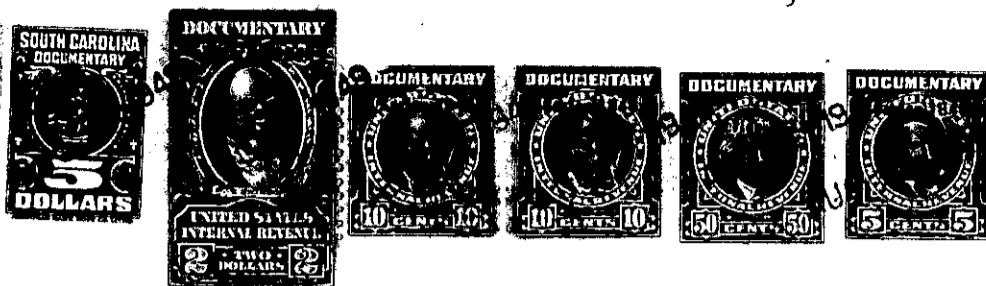

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, Nettie W. Harrison, Hattie Mae Wakefield, Effie Belle McCullough, Lucile W. Poole and C. G. Walker in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Four Hundred (\$2400.00) Dollars to US in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Yancy Newsome (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Yancy Newsome, his heirs and assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, situated on the eastern side of Endel Street and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Endel Street corner of lot heretofore conveyed by W. C. Cleveland to Mr. Miller, and running thence with Miller's line S. 67 1/2 E. 151 1/2 ft. to an iron pin on 12 foot alley, thence along line of said alley S. 20 W. 50 1/2 ft. more or less, to an iron pin, thence N. 67 1/2 W. 152 1/2 ft. to Endel Street iron pin, thence along said Endel Street to the beginning corner, N. 23 1/2 E. 50 1/2 ft, more or less.

This being the same property conveyed to William Walker by Marshall Thompson on December 11, 1919, recoded in Vol. 57, page 239, R. M. C. Office Greenville County S.C.
