

That' I, Fred A. Fuller, in the State aforesaid. the exchange of property valued at \$19,000.00 in consideration of the sum of - - DOLLARS

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. H. Cox and H. N. Cox, their heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying and being on the Southeastern side of the Mountain Creek Road at a point where said Mountain Creek Road intersects with the State Park Road (formerly known as Reservoir Road) containing 21.73 acres, more or less, as shown on a plat of property of F. A. Andress made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, dated September 26, 1943, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book Page and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of the intersection of Countain Creek Road and State Park Road and running thence along the line of property now or formerly owned by Greene, S. 21-15 E. 1471 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 44+ 45 E. 185.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 81-30 E. 135 feet to a spruce pine; thence N. 75-00 E. 224 feet to a spruce pine; thence S. 51-00 E. 151 feet to a stake; thence N. 8-30 E. crossing a branch 281 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 68-45 W. 111 feet to a stake; thence II. 78-30 W. 130.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 44-45 E. 527 feet to an iron pin in the line of property now or formerly belonging to Hubbard; thence with Hubbard's line, N. 58-45 W. 1261 feet to an iron pin on the Southeast side of the Mountain Crock Road; thoncecrossing the Mountain Creek Road, S. 72-00 W. 231 feet to the beginning corner, being same shown on County Block Book as Lot 21, Block 3, on Page P-25.

The above described property is the same conveyed to me by J. A. Whiteside and Evelyn Whiteside by decd dated May 7, 1947, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S.
