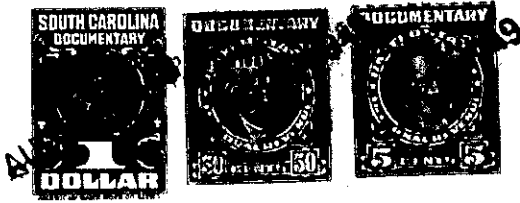

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, A.L. Cannon,
in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Twenty-five
(\$125.00) Dollars
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by Lee Mason
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lee Mason and his heirs and
assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oneal Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, lying on the East side of the Greer-Cneal
Highway, State Highway No. 13, about three miles northwest of Greer,
being all of lot No. 5 on Plat No. 1 of the R.B. Mason Estate
property, prepared by H.L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, dated August 17, 1947,
recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and having the
following courses and distances: BEGINNING at a stake on the East side
of said highway, joint corner of lots Nos. 5 and 6 on said plat, and
runs thence with the common line of said lots in an easterly direction
200 feet to a stake on line of lot No. 21; thence S. 14 E. 100 feet
to a stake, joint corner of lots 4 and 5; thence with the common line
of these lots in a westerly direction 200 feet to a stake on the East
side of said highway; thence with the East side thereof N. 14 W. 100
feet to the beginning corner, containing .44 acres, more or less.
