BEGINNING at a persimmon tree near the old road on the Northeastern side of the Railroad; thence in an easterly direction, Two Hundred Ten (210) feet, more or less, to a mountain pine on the Johnson corner; thence along the Johnson line in a northerly direction, Two Hundred Ten (210) feet, more or less, to a rock corner on the Hart land; thence in a southwestern direction along the line of the Southern land property to the beginning corner; and containing One (1) acre, more or less.
