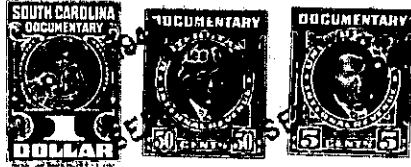

F. Neal, all that piece, parcel and lot of land being a part of Lot No. 79 on Beechwood Avenue according to plat made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, of the property of Thomas M. Wright and Ruth Hannah Wright, said plat dated the 21st day of January, 1944 and more particularly described as follows: to-wit,

"Beginning at a stake on Maco Street; thence one hundred (100) feet N. 19-05 E. to a wooden stake; thence S. 71-55 E. 60 feet to a wooden stake; thence S. 18-32 W. approximately 40.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 64-30 W. 86.9 feet to the beginning stake."
