BEGINNING at a stake on the North side of Croft Street a distance of 217 feet and 6 inches east of the Northeast corner of Croft and Robinson Streets and a: the joint corner of Lots Nos. 22 and 24 and thence running along the joint line of said Lots, N. 1-41 E. 208 feet to a stakein the approximate center of former alley; thence parallel with the line of said former alley N. 83-13 W. 54 feet to a stake; thence S 1-41 W 208 feet to a stake on Croft Street; thence along Croft Street S 83 -13 E. 54 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Eva May Green by deed dated August 31, 1928, and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 136 page 338. By agreement of all abutting landowners, the 16 foot alley originally at the rear of said lot was closed so that all abutting property owners on said alley acquired 8 feet additional in the depth or said lots, which were originally 200 feet in depth. This agreement was dated April 8, 1924, and signed by C. G. Wyche, E. E. Stone, Et al., and recorded in R. M. C. Office for said County in Deed Book, Volume 100 page 204. Recently by agreement, with the adjoining landowner to the West, a concrete wall was built running from the Croft Street sidewalk to a distance of about 100 feet toward the rear.
