

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in

State of South Carolina, on the South side of Fortner Street and being known and designated as Lot No. 6, in Block "A" of a subdivision known as "Sunny Slope", and shown by a plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "F", at Page 86, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Southeast corner of the intersection of Fortner Street and Zarline Street and running thence along the South side of Fortner Street, S. 80-05 E., 50 feet to an iron pin at corner of Lot No. 5; thence along the line of that lot, S. 9-48 W., 150 feet to an iron pin at rear corner of said lot in line of Lot No. 7; thence along line of Lot No. 7, N. 80-05 W., 50 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Zarline Street; thence along the East side of Zarline Street, N. 9-48 E., 150 feet to the beginning corner.

As a part of the consideration the Grantees assume and agree to pay the balance due of \$4200.00 on that certain mortgage covering said property, executed by G. Thurmon Owens to the First Federal Savings & Loan Association of Greenville, S. C., on August 26, 1949, recorded in said R. M. C. Office in Mortgage Book 435 at Page 393.
