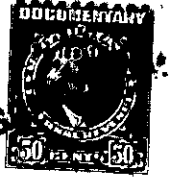

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That First Pentecostal Church, Inc.,
a South Carolina corporation

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina

and having its principal place of business at
Greenville, in the State of South Carolina

for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty One Hundred No/100 (\$3100.) Dollars,
and assumption of mortgage hereafter referred to

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee
hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Angeline D.
Leslie, her heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the City
of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being
situate at the Southwest corner of the intersection of Hampton
Avenue and Frank Street, and being more particularly described as
follows:

BEGINNING at a stake in angle of Frank Street; thence N. 56 1/2
E. 112 feet to a stake on Hampton Avenue; thence N. 34 1/2 W. 101 feet
along Hampton Avenue to a stake; thence S. 56 1/2 W. with lower's line
133 3/4 feet to a stake; thence with lower's line, 101 feet to the
beginning corner.

The above is shown on the City Block Book as Lot 12 of Block
3, Sheet 26. The above is the same property conveyed to First
Pentecostal Church, Inc. by I. H. Ambrose by deed dated March 1,
1946, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County,
S. C. in Deed Book 232, Page 79.

The grantee assumes the balance due on said mortgage held by
I. H. Ambrose, which balance is \$3400.00 as of this date, said mort-
gage is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C.
