all that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, about three miles northwest from Greer, on the west side of the road that leads from Taylor's Packing Shed to the Mosteller Road, and being bounded on the north, west and south by lands of W. P. Vaughn, and on the east by the said road and lands of (now or formerly) of J. P. Taylor, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by deed from W. P. Vaughn September 23rd 1942, and having the following courses and distances, to wit :-

Beginning on a stake on the west edge of the above named road, and being on or near the J. P. Taylor line, and runs thence with the said road S. 28-15 W. 121 feet to a stake in the west edge of the said road (iron pin on the west bank 11 feet from the true corner); thence N. 73-15 W. 255 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 15-15 E. 206 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 73-15 E. 232 feet to a stake in the gully and on or near the J.
