(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said William T. Coleman.....

All our/right, title, and interest in and to

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, consisting of 5.52 acres, located on the West side of Highway 25, as per plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book W, page 23, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Highway 25 at the joint corner of the Fannie M. Coleman property and running thence along the line of the Fannie M. Coleman property, N 52-30 W 289 feet to an iron pin; thence S 27-20 W 95.6 feet to an iron pin; thence N 72-15 W 224 feet to an iron pin in the center of a road; thence along the center of said road, N 25-15 W 23 feet to an iron pin; thence along the center of said road N 21-45 W 198 feet to an iron pin; thence N 30-47 E 235 feet to an iron pin; thence S 62-30 E 203.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S 32-35 E 114 feet to an iron pin; thence S 27-36 E 77.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S 60-02 E 123 feet to an iron pin; thence N 57-24 E 141 feet to an iron pin; thence N 52-12 E 179.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N 41-46 E 239.3 feet to an iron pin in the line of Highway 25; thence along the West side of said Highway 25, S 28-30 W 715.5 feet to the point of beginning.
