KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT, WHEREAS, on the 10th day of November 1943, J. L. Brashier hereinafter called the "Borrower", executed a security instrument to the United States of America to secure a loan in the sum of \$3965.00, made under the provisions of Title I of the Bankhead-Jones Farm Tenant Act, covering the hereinafter described real estate, which security instrument was recorded in the Office of the Clerk of Court of Greenville County, South Carolina on 29th day of Nov. in Mortgage Book 323, page 58; and 1943

WHEREAS, the Borrower desires to execute the hereinafter described easement or right-of-way on and across the lands described in the aforesaid security instrument, and therefore, desires a subordination of the lien of said security instrument to the rights granted in said easement or right-of-way;

NOW, THEREFORE, the United States of America, for a valuable consideration, does hereby subordinate from the lien of said security instrument unto the borrower, or his assigns, subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth, the following: Beginning at an iron pin at corner of E.L. Martin and running thence S. 29-45 W. along lands of First Carolina Joint Stock Land Bank and J. N. Culbertson, crossing Harrison Bridge Road 2469 feet to a stake at corner of N. A. Henderson; thence with said Henderson line and line of E. L. Martin N. 59-00 W. 1667 feet to a stone; thence N. 29-00 E. and running with line of E. L. Martin property and J. A. Leopard, crossing Harrison Bridge Road 2093 feet to iron pin in branch at corner of E. L. Martin; thence up said branch and following the meanders thereof the following courses and distances: S 71-15 E. 432 ft. S 71-45 E 736 ft; S 72-00 E 390 ft; due East 187 ft. to the beginning corner. Being land described in deed dated 11/10/43, recorded in Book 258, page 361, records Greenville County, S. C. This acreage, being a part of the land described in the above real estate mortgage, is being released to the Trans-continental Gas Pipe Line Corporation for a right-of-way.

It is expressly understood, however, that this Agreement shall not affect or impair said security instrument or any right provided therein except those rights to which said security instrument is hereby subordinated.
