KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That we, Vantross Franklin, Elizabeth Calhoun, J. C. Franklin, Geo. C. Franklin, Lenj. S. Franklin, Robert Franklin, Nannie F. Miller, Alice M. Land, Lula P. Pope

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Forty-five (45.00) Dollars

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Eveline Sloan

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Eveline Sloan

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, in the Laurel Creek section, containing 45/100 acres, and being a portion of the lands owned by Ida J. Franklin at the time of her death. It is more specifically described as follows:

BEGINNING at a pin in road and running thence N. 50 E. 5.95 to pin in field; thence S. 69 E. .85 links to stake in field; thence S. 50 W. 6.00 to pin in road; thence along road N. 41 W. .85 links to beginning.

All private or plantation roads adjoining or passing over the described lands shall remain open for the use and benefit of the owner of this and other properties of the grantors or their grantees.

Ida J. Franklin died years ago intestate owning this and other lands. She left as her sole heirs at law her husband, G. C. Franklin and her eight children. Later G. C. Franklin married Vantross Franklin, and died thereafter, intestate, leaving as his sole heirs at law, his widow, Vantross, and the eight children by his first wife, Ida J; and the grantors herein are therefore the sole heirs of both Ida J. Franklin and G. C. Franklin.
