

conference shall approve the proposition by a two-thirds majority of those present at the said conference, the said Board of Trustees, with the consent of the State Overseer, shall have full power to sell, transfer and convey the said real estate, or any part thereof, or to borrow money and pledge said real estate for the repayment of the same.

All of the above and foregoing limitations are those adopted by the Thirty-fifth Annual Assembly of the Church of God, held at Chattanooga, Tennessee, October 1-6, 1940, and set forth in the official minutes of the same.

And we do hereby bind ourselves and our Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said C. D. Holcombe, W. L. Vaughn and H. H. Kerns, as Trustees, as aforesaid, their Successors as such and Assigns, against ourselves and our ^{successors} Heirs and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof.
