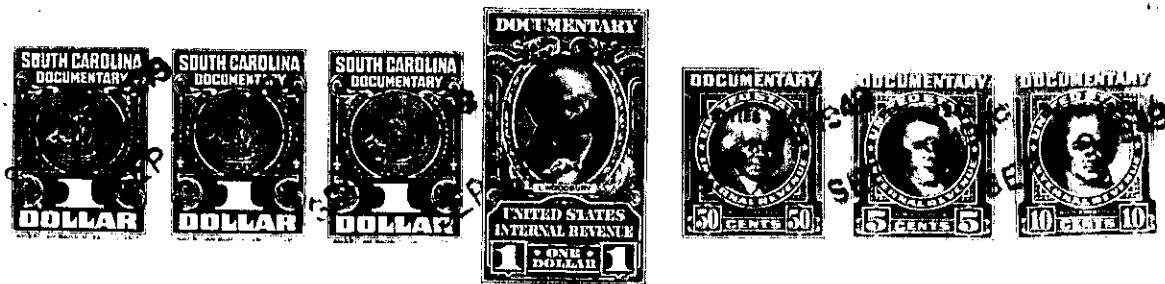

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Freda M. Griffin and her heirs and assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 50 of Northwood as shown by a plat thereof made by Dalton & Neves, dated June, 1920, and recorded, the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "M", at Pages 102 and 103, and according to said plat having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Parkwood Avenue joint corner of Lots Nos. 50 and 51 and running thence S. 71-32 E., along the line of Lot No. 51, 198.3 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 23; thence S. 9-16 E., 66 feet to an iron pin joint corner Lots Nos. 50, 21 and 22; thence E. 71-32 E., along the line of Lots Nos. 21, 20 and 19, 210 feet to an iron pin on Parkwood Avenue; thence E. 19-30 E. along Parkwood Avenue 65 feet to the beginning corner.

This property is in School District 7-IC and is shown on the Greenville Township Block Book as Lot No. 32, Section 5, Page 187.
