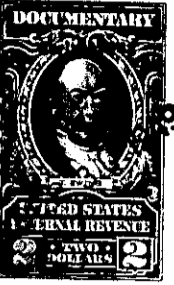
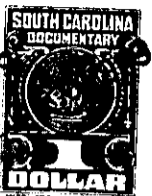
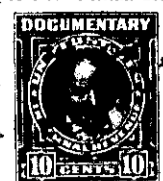

(\$1875.00) Dollars
to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by Rosa G. Moore
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Rosa G. Moore

All our right, title and interest which is a 3/12 undivided interest in
and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township,
County, State of South Carolina

, in the Town of Simpsonville, and containing 22.9
acres, more or less, and being the same parcel of land conveyed to T. R.
Moore and Nannie C. Moore by W. H. Bozeman, Jr., by deed dated Feb. 28,
1929, recorded in Deed Book 148, Page 252. Said tract of land is in
the northwestern edge of the Town of Simpsonville. It begins on a stone
at edge of road and runs thence S. 80 W. 4.88 to a black oak; thence
S. 51 1/2 W. 5.80 to a stake in gully; thence S. 36 1/2 W. 30 links to
stone in branch; thence down said branch S. 47 W. 3.00 to bend therein;
thence continuing down said branch S. 43 W. 5.15 to a stake in branch;
thence S. 84 1/2 E. 13.50 to a stone; thence N. 60 E. 11.75 to stone
in edge of old oak; thence along that road 12.33 to the beginning corner.
The aforesaid tract of land was owned by T. R. Moore and Nannie C.
Moore at the time of the death of Nannie C. Moore, intestate, in 1933.
Upon her death intestate her interest in the said tract of land went
to her heirs at law who were her husband, T. R. Moore and her four
