












KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Jasper G. Moore; Zuliene H. Ball

All our right, title and interest which is a 3/12 undavided interest in all that piece, parcel or lot of land in County, State of South Carolina , in the Town of Simpsonville, and containing 22.9 acres, more or less, and being the same parcel of land conveyed to T. R. Moore and Nannie C. Moore by W. H. Bozeman, Jr., by deed dated Feb. 28, 1929, recorded in Deed Book 148, Page 252. Said tract of land is in the northwestern edge of the Town of Simpsonville. It begins on a stone at edgo of road and runs thence S. 80 W. 4.88 to a black cak; thence S. 51 1/2 W. 5.80 to a stake in gully; thonco S. 36 1/2 M. 30 links to stone in branch; thence down said branch S. 47 W. 3.00 to bend therein; thence continuing down said branch S. 3 W. 5.15 to a stake in branch; thence S. 84 1/2 E. 13.50 to a stone; thence N. 60 E. 11.75 to stone in edge of old oak; thence along that road12.33 to the beginning corner. The aforesaid tract of land was owned by T. R. Moore and Mannie C. Moore at the time of the death of Nannie C. Moore, intestate, in 1933. Upon her death intestate her interest in the said tract of land went to her heirs at law who were her husband, T. R. Moore and her four children, Jasper C. Moore, Zuliene M. Ball, William T.
