WHEREAS, Hugh Beasley, of Greenwood, S. C., was formerly the Committee of Wiley Johnson and as such held title to the lot of land hereinafter described by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 174, Page 104; and,

WHEREAS, subsequently on October 29, 1945, the undersigned, as Committee for Wiley Johnson The First National Bank of Greenville, S. C., was named successor and duly appointed Committee for the said Wiley Johnson by the Probate Judge for Greenville County, S. C. as will appear by Apartment 470, File 12 on file in said office and having fully performed its duties as such Committee it was duly discharged by said Probate Judge and letters dismissory were duly issued on March 27, 1946; and,

WHEREAS, Wiley Johnson died testate on June 1, 1945, and his will was duly admitted to Probate in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County, S. C. on the 13th day of June, 1945 and letters testamentary were issued by said Probate Court to Sarah Johnson on June 26, 1945, and letters dismissory were duly issued to her on January 23, 1947, all of which will more fully appear at Apartment 497, File 20, Probate Judge's Office for Greenville County, S. C.; and,

WHEREAS, by Item III of said will the testator devised the lot of land hereinafter described to his wife, the said Sarah Johnson, but no conveyance was made to her by this Committee transferring the legal title to said property to her; and,

WHEREAS, Sarah Johnson died intestate in Greenville, S. C. on June 24, 1948 leaving surviving her as her only heirs at law and distributees her six brothers and sisters as follows: Mrs. Jessie
