all that piece, parcel or lot of land in

Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, on the Conestee Road near the Greenville Army Air Base and being known and designated as Lots 28 and 29 of Oakland Gardens, property of Thomas F. McCourry and having, according to plat of same made by Dalton & Neves in March, 1942, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-
