presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Furman Owens, his Heirs and

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, located near Fairview Baptist Church, lying on
the north side of the old Buncombe Road, being bounded on the
north by lot of Furman Owens, on the east by other lands of
myself, on the south by the said Old Buncombe Road and on the
west by lot of Mrs. Wyche, and being a part of tract No. 1
as shown on Plat of Property of John T. Taylor, made by H. S. #
Brockman, Surveyor, 19 , and having the following courses
and distances, to wit:-

Beginning on an iron pin on Mrs. Wyche's line and being
the southwest corner of Furman Owens' lot, and runs thence with
the line of Mrs. Wyche S. 10-15 W. 313 feet to a stake in the
center of the Old Buncombe Road; thence with the center of the
said road S. 57-45 W. 90.3 feet to a stake in the center of
the road; thence N. 10-35 E, 380 feet to an iron pin, the south-
east rear corner of the Furman Owens lot; thence with the rear
line of the Furman Owens lot S. 78-48 W. 90.2 feet to the
beginning corner, and containing Sixty Seven One-hundredths
(0.67) of one acre, more or less.
