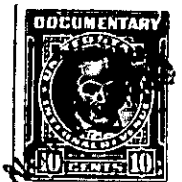

 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
 presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Anna J. Stathos, her heirs
 and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in what is now the City of Greenville on the northeast side of the Laurens Road and being known and designated as Lot No. 5 on plat of property of C. F. Putman, recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book F, page 240, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeast side of Laurens Road, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5, running thence along the line of Lots Nos. 4 and 5, N. 34-18 E. 200 feet, more or less, to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5, which iron pin is also on the line of Lot No. 17 as shown on said plat; thence along line of Lot No. 17, S. 55-45 E. 67 feet to an iron pin on the line of Lot No. 17, at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 5 and 6; thence along the line of Lot No. 6, S. 34-18 W. 200 feet to an iron pin on the northeast side of Laurens Road, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 5 and 6; thence running along the Laurens Road, N. 55-45 W. 67 feet to the beginning corner.

Being the same property conveyed to N. Y. Kellett by J. W. Putman by deed dated April 13, 1925, and recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 97, page 111.

The said N. Y. Kellett died intestate on June 26, 1929, leaving the grantor herein as his sole heir at law and distributees as is shown by the record of his estate on file in the office of the Probate Court for Greenville County in Apartment 290, File 19.
