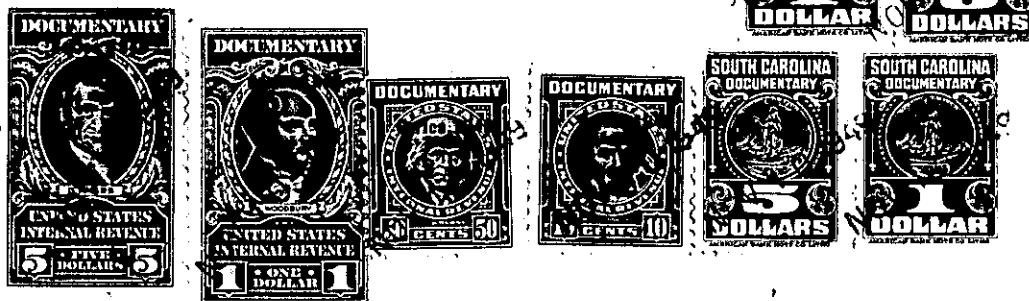

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Gantt Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 213, according to plat of Section A of the property of Woodfields, Inc., a subdivision located on the southwest side of the Augusta Road, which plat was made by the Piedmont Engineering Service on August 29, 1949, and which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book W, at page 75 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southeastern side of Fox Hall Road at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 212 and 215 and running thence along the line of Lot No. 212 S. 64-06 E. 151 feet to an iron pin on a branch; thence with said branch as the line S. 15-23 W. 71.2 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 214; thence along the line of Lot No. 213 N. 64-06 W. 164 feet to an iron pin on Fox Hall Road; thence along Fox Hall Road N. 25-54 E. 70 feet to an iron pin at the point of beginning.
