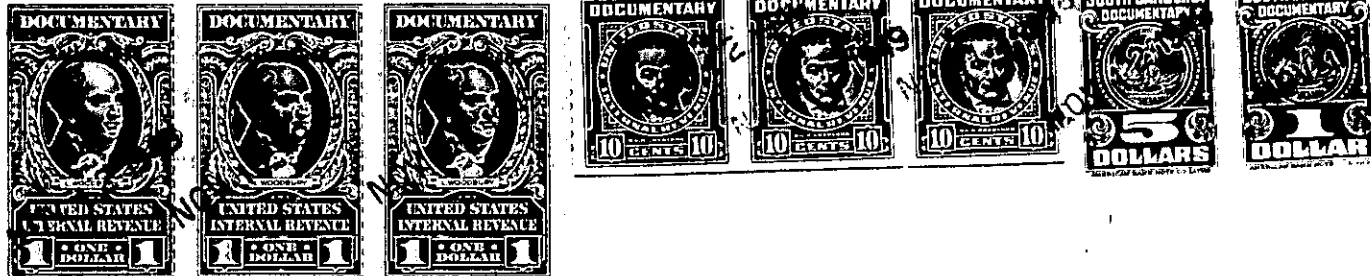

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said MRS BIRDIE WOODSON

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in BATES Township, GREENVILLE

County, State of South Carolina, BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of the intersection of the Blythe Road and the Rifle Range Road, and running thence along the line of the Rifle Range Road and lands of Ophelia Ferguson, S 56-28 E. 397.2 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along said Rifle Range Road and lands of Ophelia Ferguson, S. 27-33 E. 840 feet to an iron pin in the intersection of the Rifle Range Road with a County Road and which point is on the line of Property of L. B. HART; thence, along the Hart line N. 70-03 W. 1100 feet to an iron pin in center of an old road; thence along said road, now or formerly known as the Blythe Road, N. 11-03 E. 149.8 feet; thence continuing along said road N. 32-49 E. 526.2 feet to an iron pin at the point of beginning.
