in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said G. M. McDonald, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, School District 8-AB, on the south side of Seventh Street, being known as Lot No. 33 on Plat of Section 4 of Judson Mills Village, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in January, 1941, recorded in Plat Book "K", at pages 75 and 76, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the South side of Seventh Street, 133.7 feet West from Newbert Avenue, at corner of Lot No. 34, and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 1-42 E. 118.5 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 4; thence with the line of said lot, S. 88-05 W. 80 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 32; thence with the line of said lot, N. 1-42 W. 118.6 feet to a stake on Seventh Street; thence with the South side of Seventh Street, N. 88-10 E. 80 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described lot is the same conveyed to us by Y. V. Dudley by his deed dated September 4, 1946, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 298, page 325.

This lot is shown on the Township Block Book at Sheet 111, Block 15, Lot No. 7, and the grantee is to pay taxes for 1949, said taxes having been prorated as of this date.
