N. Helton, his heirs and assigns forever,

A portion of that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chicks Springs Township, as shown on survey of the property of J. P. Rosamond, dated April 27, 1945, by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, and having according to said survey the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on county road corner of Batson property and running thence along said road N. 51 E. 45 feet to a point in said road; thence S. 37-30 E. 198 feet more or less to a point in line of Grantors' property; thence S. 45-45 W. 45 feet to a stone at corner of Smith property, Mrs. Batson and Roasmond property; thence along the line of Batson property N. 37-30 W. 270 feet to the point of beghning

The county road is sometimes called the Batson Road.
