which has been duly and regularly organized, did on the 3rd day of
December, A. D. 1949 file with the Secretary of State a written declaration setting forth:

That, at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held pursuant to the by-laws or regulations of the said organization, they
were authorized and directed to apply for incorporation.

That, the said organization holds, or desires to hold, property in common for Religious, Educational, Social, Fraternal, Char-
itable or other eleemosynary purpose, or any two or more of said purposes, and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain
to the members, otherwise than is above stated, nor for the insurance of life, health, accident or property; and that three days'
notice in the Greenville Piedmont, a newspaper published in the
County of Greenville, has been given that the aforesaid Declaration would be filed.

AND WHEREAS, Said Declarants and Petitioners further declared and affirmed:

FIRST: Their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: The name of the proposed Corporation is GREENVILLE ART ASSOCIATION

THIRD: The place at which it proposes to have its headquarters or be located is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: The purpose of the said proposed Corporation is to establish, maintain and
conduct a non-profit public art gallery for the education, exhibition and
encouragement of the fine and useful arts, said corporation to do any and all
things necessary or incident to the operation thereof and to possess any and
all powers usually possessed by corporations of such character.

SIXTH: That they desire to be incorporated: in perpetuity

NOW, THEREFORE, I, P. T. BRADHAM, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in
me vested, by Chapter 158, Article III, Code of 1942, and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby declare the said organization to be
a body politic and corporate, with all the rights, powers, privileges and immunities, and subject to all the limitations and liabilities,
conferred by said Chapter 158, Article III, Sections 8158-8159 and 8168, Code of 1942, and Acts amendatory thereto.

forty-nine and in the one hundred and
