NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$6000.00

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said Rev. J. F. Finley

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land on Pinckney Street, City of
Greenville, County and State aforesaid, having the following metes and
bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at the joint corner of Lots 16 and 18 (as shown on a
plat of McBee Lands, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County,
S. C., in Plat Book A, Page 83) and running thence along Pinckney Street
N. 50½ W. 30 feet; thence S. 39½ W. 131 feet, more or less, to a stake
on the alley in the rear; thence along said alley S. 52-2/3 E. 50 feet;
thence in a straight line, N. 39½ E. 130 feet, more or less, to a point
on Pinckney Street; thence along Pinckney Street, N. 50½ W. 20 feet to
the point of beginning. This being the same land conveyed to Alice J.
Gunn by deed of J. L. Anderson, dated December 14, 1912, said deed being
recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book
20, at Page 376."
