does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the County of Greenville

An easement and right-of-way for the purpose of constructing a  
road in, over and through that strip of land in Butler Township, Green-  
ville County, S. C. being 18 feet in width and lying along the South  
edge and along the West edge of that 20 acre tract of land conveyed by  
the Grantor to C. Thomas Wyche and being shown as a portion of that road  
leading West from the Parkins Mill Road and shown as Cavalier Drive on  
plat made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, February 1944, recorded in the R.  
M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book W, page 97.

The right-of-way over the above strip of land is to be used for  
laying out and maintaining a public road.
