to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said R. E. Ingold, his heirs and assigns;

All that piece, parcel or tract of land in Grove Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on waters of Grove Creek, containing Forty One and 73/100 (41.73) acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a poplar adjoining the McKenzie land, and running thence N. 12 E. 15.64 to branch; thence along the meanders of said branch, 24.00 to a stone; thence S. 33 W. 10.50 to an iron pin; thence S. 17 1/2 W. 25.00 to an iron pin; thence N. 41 3/4 W. 20.77 to the point of beginning.

This is the same property conveyed to me by W. T. Henderson and N. O. McDowell, Jr., by deed dated October 9, 1943, recorded in Vol. 257 at page 200 in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County.

The property hereinabove described, was originally conveyed to Grantor herein, in deed naming \$1800.00 as consideration, which was paid in full by the Grantee in this deed, and title was put in the name of Leta H. Ingold, who is the wife of the Grantee in this deed, and it is now desired that the title of said property be placed in the name of R. E. Ingold, her husband, who is the true owner thereof, he having paid all the consideration.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s') Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
