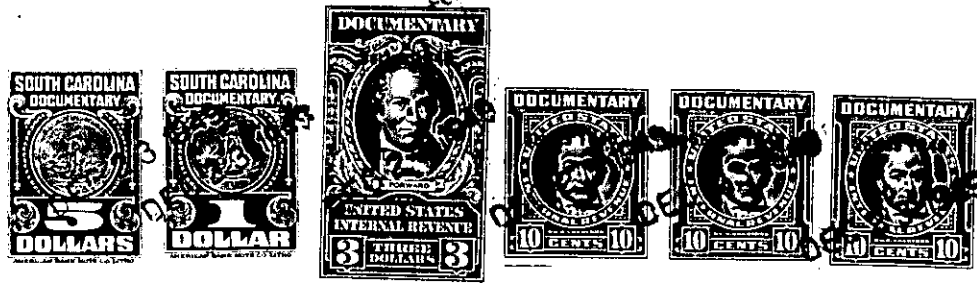

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said **Frank Abercrombie and Clarice  
Abercrombie -**

**All those two**  
~~all that~~ piece, parcel or lot of land in **Austin** Township, **Greenville**

County, State of South Carolina, located about one-half mile North from the  
Town of Simpsonville, in the Simpsonville School District, lying  
on the North side of a surface treated road that leads from  
Simpsonville by the Jonesville School, being all of lots Nos. 1  
and 2 on a plat of property made for S. T. Holland by J. Q. Bruce,  
Surveyor, dated Oct. 14, 1949, recorded in the Greenville County  
R. M. C. Office in Plat Book W, at page 103, and having the  
following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING on a stake on the Northern edge of said road, the  
southernmost corner of lot # 2, and running thence N. 42.11 E.  
185 feet to the center of a branch (stake on the south side of  
branch); thence up and with the meanders of said branch as the  
line N. 52.10 W. 158 feet to a bend; thence up branch N. 83.45 W.  
113 feet to a stake; thence S. 35.38 W. 171 feet to a stake on the  
northern edge of said road; thence with the road S. 52.10 E. 100  
feet, S. 56.24 E. 71 feet, and S. 85.41 E. 78 feet to the  
beginning corner.

The above described land is **identically** the same conveyed to me by  
**S. T. Holland** on the **28th** day of  
**November** 19**49**, deed recorded in office Register of Mesne Conveyance for
