

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Cleveland

Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina. being known and designated as Lot No. 1 as shown on plat made by J. B. Chastain, Surveyor, July 12, 1949 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point 15 feet South from the center of pipe line paralleling the Saluda river, which point is the joint corner of Lots No. 1 and property now owned or formerly owned by Clara Bates Turner; thence along property of Clara Bates Turner South 18 East 196 feet, more or less, to a stone xn on the North bank of the Saluda River; thence along the North bank of Saluda River in a Northeasterly direction 66 feet to a stone xn at the joint southern corner of Lots 1 and 2; thence along line of Lot No. 2, North 23 West 2.77 chains to a stone 15 feet south of the middle of a pipe line; thence South 46-30 West 66 feet to the point of beginning and containing 2.16 acres, more or less.

This property is sold subject to the following restrictions:

- 1. It is distinctly understood that this property is sold subject to a 25-foot roadway which is to be cut along the pipe line for the common use of all the property owners.
- 2. This property is to be sued for residential purposes only and no trade or business can be carried on that will create or constitute a nuisance.
