This agreement, made and entered into this the 4th day of January, 1950, by and between Harold P. Sizemore, of Greenville, South Carolina, hereinafter referred to as "Sizemore", and Thomas A. Cushman, of Rock Hill, South Carolina, hereinafter referred to as "Cushman".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Sizemore and Cushman formed a partnership under date of September 1, 1949, whereby Sizemore was to retain fifty-five per cent (55%) of the entire assets and to act as Manager, and Cushman was to purchase forty-five per cent (45%) of the assets in the operation of a cafe known as the "Colonial Cafe" on the New Buncombe Highway in Greenville, South Carolina, and,

WHEREAS, Sizemore executed a Bill of Sale on September 1, 1949, to Cushman conveying to him forty-five per cent (45%) of the entire assets of the said business, showing as consideration Two Thousand Eight Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$2,800.00), and on the same day, for the total consideration of Two Thousand Eight Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$2,800.00), Cushman executed a note to Sizemore, secured by a chattel mortgage over his forty-five per cent (45%) interest in said business, and,

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to dissolve the partnership and Cushman desires to convey by this instrument his entire interest in the said business to Sizemore and Sizemore agrees to cancel the said note and chattel mortgage executed by Cushman.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Twenty-Five and No/100 Dollars (\$125.00) in hand paid by Sizemore to Cushman, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, it is mutually agreed that the partnership entered into between the parties on September 1, 1949, be and the same is hereby dissolved.
