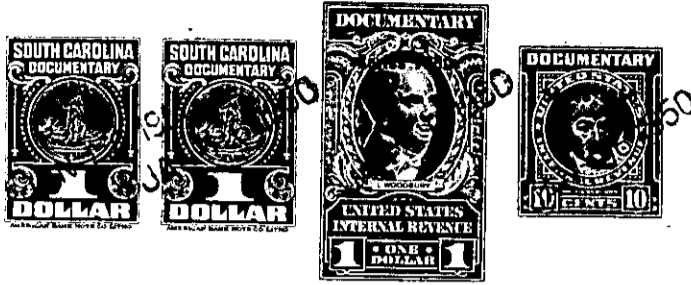

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, on the Northern side of Sulpha Springs Road,  
and being known and designated as lot #1 of a subdivision known as  
Highview Acres a Plat of which is of record in the R.M.C. Office
