That I, John T. Abercrombie in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand and No/100- - - - - (\$2,000.00) DOLLARS, in the State aforesaid,

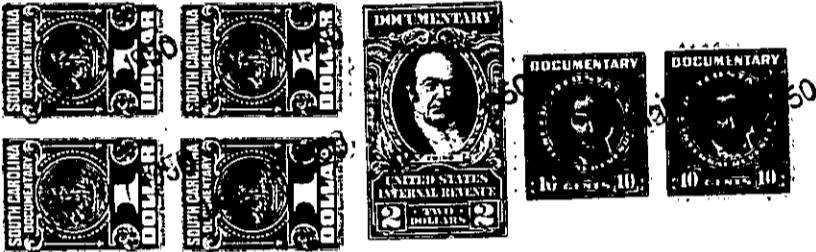
to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said T. B. Nalley, his Heirs and Assigns forever,

All those lots of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Northwestern side of Franklin Road, near the City of Greenville, being shown as Lots Nos. 29 and 30 on Plat of McCullough Heights, recorded in Plat Book E at Page 95 and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Northwestern side of Franklin Road, 60 feet Southwest from Grove Street, at corner of Lot No. 28, and running thence with the line of said lot, N. 44-20 W. 164 feet to a stake on an alley; thence with the Southeastern side of said alley, S. 45-26 W. 120 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 31; thence with the line of said lot, S. 44-20 E. 164 feet to a stake on Franklin Road; thence with the Northwestern side of Franklin Road, N. 45-26 E. 120 feet to the beginning corner.

Said premises being two of the lots conveyed to the Grantor by Paro Abercrombie by deed dated January 31, 1940, recorded in Book of Deeds 218 at Page 107.
