CHARTER
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

E. S. TOOHEY AND E. S. TOOHEY, JR.

did on the 16th day of January, 1950, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is CENTRAL PARKING GARAGE, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is storing, parking, repairing and servicing of motor vehicles and other instruments or vehicles used for means of transportation, either private or public; also, to buy or sell and develop real estate; to engage in the buying and selling of merchandise, repair parts and equipment, either at wholesale or retail, or both; and to have all other powers now conferred upon a business corporation by the laws of the State of South Carolina.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) - - - - - Dollars payable in cash, equipment or services upon the call of the Board of Directors and as may be specified by said Board.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is One Hundred (100) of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) - - - - - Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 12th day of January, 1950, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors:

E. S. Toohey and E. S. Toohey, Jr.

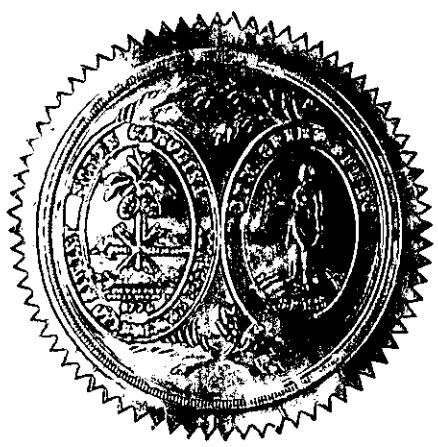
EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, E. S. Toohey ; as Vice-President, E. S. Toohey, Jr. ; as Secretary, E. S. Toohey, Jr. ; as Treasurer, E. S. Toohey

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1942, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Piedmont

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville, S. C.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the afore-said Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
