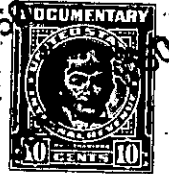
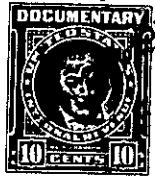
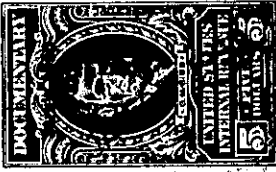

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, adjoining the lands of Woodside Cotton Mills on Woodside Avenue, starting at the centre of the intersection of Seventh Street and Woodside Ave. thence N. 82°-49' E-1000 ft. to centre of street, thence S. 6° 49' W- 604 ft. to corner, thence N. 84° 55' W. 142 ft. to corner thence N. 10°- 23' E. 214 ft. to corner thence N. 84°- 55' W. 860 ft. to center of street, thence down Centre St.- N. 10°- 54' E. 184 ft. to beginning corner, containing thirty-one lots, seven and one-tenth acres, as shown by blue print attached made by J.
