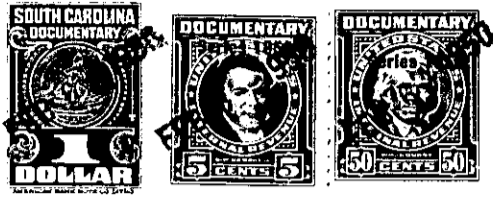

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ina M. Elmore; her heirs and
assigns,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mt. Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina having the following metes and bounds and
courses and distances: Beginning at a point of intersection of
the new and old Davison Road, the Elmore and Dawson corner.
Thence N. 64.45 W. 409 feet to a stake on the Elmore line, thence
S. 85.00 E. 452.5 feet to a point in New Davison Road, thence with
said road S. 31.00 W. 158.5 feet to the beginning corner. Containing
seventy three one-hundreds (.73) Acres.
