in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lewis F. Watson, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Fairview Township, School District 5-D, and containing 86.07 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stone 3x, and running thence N. 25 3/4 E. 6.00 chains; thence N. 24 1/2 E. 12.58 chains; thence N. 24 1/2 E. 21.06 chains; thence S. 65 E. 6.08 chains; thence S. 13 E. 8.00 chains; thence S. 35 E. 5.30 chains; thence S. 25 1/2 E. 7.82 chains; thence S. 13 1/2 E. 5.83 chains; thence S. 11 1/2 E. 9.60 chains; thence S. 58 1/2 W. 16.13 chains; thence N. 65 1/3 W. 22.05 chains to the beginning corner, and being bounded by the lands of A. S. Howard estate on the North, by the Goldsmith estate on the East, Mrs. Joe Leake on the West and by Mr. West on the South.
