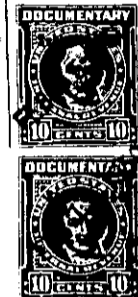


Know All Men by These Presents:

in consideration of the sum of Eight Thousand Six Hundred Fifty and No/100 (\$8,650.00) --- DOLLARS,

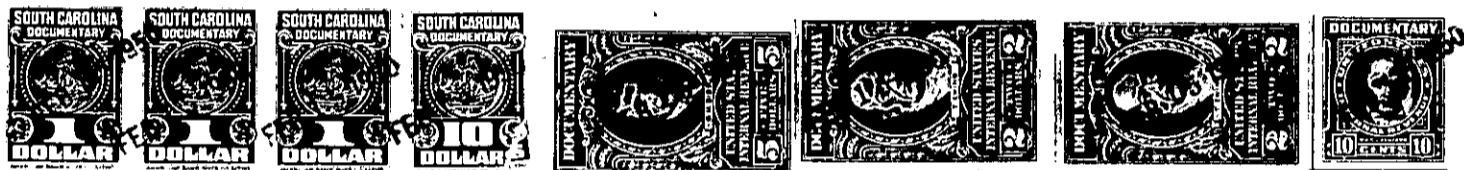
to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said ERNEST S. GRAY, his heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, lying and being situate on the Northern side of Potomac Avenue, within the limits of the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot # 178 and the Easterly and adjoining 15 feet of Lot # 179, Pleasant Valley, according to plat of said subdivision prepared by Dalton & Neves in April, 1946, including additions to said plat through November, 1948, as recorded in the R.M.C. Office, Greenville, South Carolina, in Plat Book "P", at Page 92, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Potomac Avenue at joint front corner of Lots # 177 and # 178, said pin being 370 feet Northeast of iron pin in the Northeast corner of the intersection of Potomac Avenue with Panama Avenue; thence N. 0-08 W. 160 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots # 177 and # 178; thence S. 89-52 E. 75 feet to an iron pin on the rear line of Lot # 179; thence S. 0-08 E. 160 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of Potomac Avenue, on the front line of Lot # 179; thence along said Avenue N. 89-52 E. 75 feet to iron pin at joint front corner of Lots # 177 and # 178, the point of beginning.
