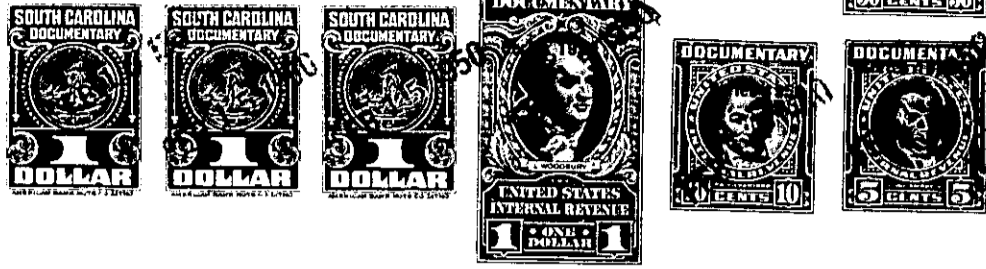

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That... We, Fred Tumblin and

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by W. O. Snyder  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. O. Snyder, his heirs and  
assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township,  
Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and  
designated as Lot No. 35 on a plat of property of J. R. West made  
by Dalton & Neves, December, 1939, recorded in the R.M.C. Office  
for Greenville County in Plat Book D at pages 314-317, and hav-  
ing, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-  
wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of West Avenue, joint  
corner of Lots Nos. 34 and 35, and running thence with line of  
Lot No. 34, N. 73-45 E. 130 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 16-15  
W. 66 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots Nos. 35 and 36;  
thence with line of Lot No. 36, S. 73-45 W. 130 feet to an iron  
pin on the east side of West Avenue; thence with West Avenue, S.  
16-15 E. 66 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner, and being  
the same lot of land conveyed to us by S. J. Gardner by deed dated  
June 30, 1947, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for the County  
and State aforesaid in Deed Book Vol. 314 at page 279.
