County, State of South Carolina and in the Town of Fountain Inn, on the West side of Weston Street, fronting 100 feet on said Street and running back in parallel lines 83 feet to an alley, being 100 feet wide in the rear along said alley, bounded by Weston Street, Alley, lot formerly belonging to B. S. Cox, now owned by the Misses Farrow and lot formerly belonging to Graves L. Knight, now owned by the Citizens Bank and the Town of Fountain Inn.

There being situate on the within described lot a brick veneer, one story residence now occupied by the Grantee.
