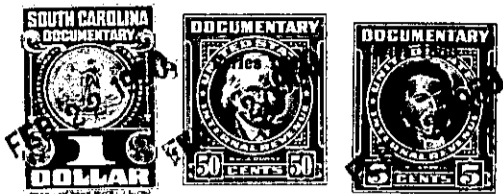

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said M. L. Kelley and his heirs and assigns
forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, on the Northeast side of Mary Street, and being shown
as Lot No. 65 on plat of Camilla Park, recorded in Plat Book "G", at Page 225,
and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 64 and 65, and
running thence with line of Lots No. 64, N. 67-50 E., 189.6 feet to iron pin
on 20 foot alley; thence with Western side of said alley, N. 18-32 W., 67.95
feet to iron pin, corner of Lot No. 66; thence with line of Lot No. 66, S. 67-
52 W., 189.2 feet to iron pin on Mary Street; thence with the East side of
Mary Street, S. 18-09 E., 68 feet to the point of beginning. Said premises
being one of the lots conveyed to the grantors by deed recorded in Volume
239 at Page 360.
