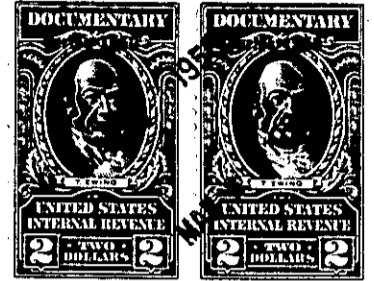
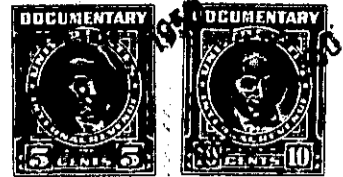

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, Greenville Township, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 129, according to a plat of the property of J. P. Rosamond, plat made by Dalton & Neves, April, 1931, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, at page 186 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the eastern side of Rutledge Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 129 and 130 and running thence along the line of Lot No. 130 S. 55-55 E. 145.6 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 145; thence along the rear line of Lots 145 and 146 N. 43-15 E. 85 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Middleton Street; thence along the southern side of Middleton Street N. 64-45 W. 156.2 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of the southern side of Middleton Street with the eastern side of Rutledge Avenue; thence along the eastern side of Rutledge Avenue S. 38-45 W. 60 feet to an iron pin at the point of beginning.
