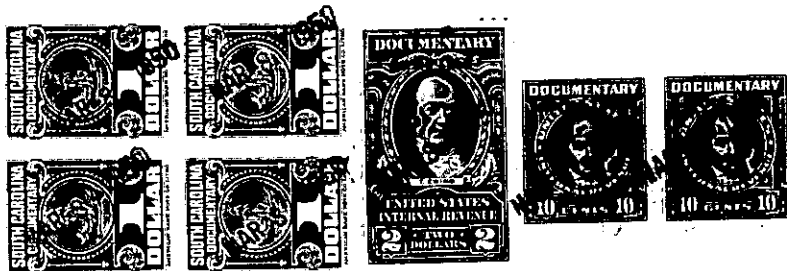

Co., February 1947, recorded in Plat Book "Q" at page 16 in the R. M.
