to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Margaret B. Blakley, her heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate and being on the North side of Pleasant Ridge Avenue, in that area recently annexed to the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot 38 on Plat of Pleasant Valley made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April 1946, revised November 1948, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "P", at pages 92 and 93, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Pleasant Ridge Avenue at joint front corner of Lots 37 and 38, and running thence with the line of Lot 37, N 0-08 W 160 feet to an iron pin; thence S 89-52 W 60 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 39 S 0-08 E 160 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Pleasant Ridge Avenue; thence along the North side of Pleasant Ridge Avenue N 89-52 E 60 feet to the beginning corner.
