Know All Men by These Presents:

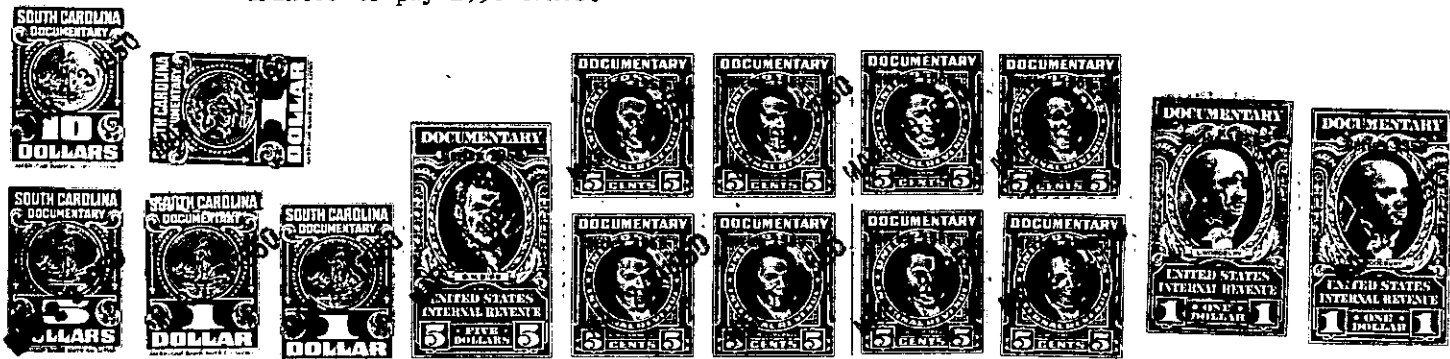

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Louis S. Courtney, his Heirs and Assigns forever,

All that lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Southern corner of Prescott Street and Blackburn Street, in the City of Greenville, and being known as Lot No. 33 on Plat of Isaqueena Park, made by Pickell & Pickell on June 3, 1946, recorded in Plat Book P at Pages 130 and 131, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Southern corner of Blackburn Street and Prescott Street, and running thence with the Southwestern side of Blackburn Street, S. 39-10 E. 75 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 34; thence with the line of said lot, S. 51-22 W. 175 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 36; thence with the line of said lot, N. 39-10 W. 75 feet to a stake on Prescott Street; thence with the Southeastern side of Prescott Street, N. 51-22 E. 175 feet to the beginning corner.
