Lot No. 1

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City and County of Greenville, State aforesaid, being on the West side of Townes Street and known as Lot No. 25, on a plat made by J. N. Southern, D. S., on December 14, 1887; said plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book "TT" at page 649, and containing one-fourth acre, more or less, and being a part of the De Camp property. Being the same property conveyed to C. Zaglin by E.
